

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- The first year provides students with a sound knowledge of the justice system and insight into Canada's current social and political structures, as well as human behaviour
- Second-year studies focus on legal issues, practices and procedures directly related to the import/export field
- Students develop essential skills in listening, observing, critical thinking, conflict management and decision making, with a strong focus on written and verbal communication

APPROXIMATE COSTS (2013-2014)

Domestic Tuition/Ancillary Fees: \$3,659 (two semesters)

Books and Supplies: \$600

Relocation and travel will likely be required to participate in placement experience – additional costs may be incurred

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Required Academic Preparation

- OSSD/OSSGD or equivalent with courses at the general, advanced, (C), (U) or (M) level, and
 - Grade 12 English (C) level or equivalent
- OR
- Mature applicant (see loyalistcollege.com)

Additional Requirements

- Criminal Record Check (Vulnerable Sector Check may also be required)
- A formal, confidential personal health history is required as part of the registration process

- Graduates are also qualified for positions as officers with Canada Border Services Agency, overseeing border services at airports and other border points
- Depending on the position, starting salaries can range from \$32,000 to \$34,000 in the private sector; entry-level government salaries begin in the mid-\$60,000s
