- Upon successful completion of the program, graduates may continue in Loyalist's General Arts and Science program with a full semester credit toward a two-year diploma, or enroll in another diploma program at Loyalist

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- The EAP program benefits people who have learned English as a second or additional language
- Students improve both their formal English language skills and functional everyday usage
- Classes emphasize effective writing, reading, listening and speaking competency
- Students choose elective courses in consultation with program faculty
- Successful completion of the program will assist graduates in achieving IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL 213 – 240 (computer-based) or 79 – 95 (Internet-based)

- Mature applicant (see loyalistcollege.com), OR
- IELTS: 5.0 overall, OR
- TOEFL: Computer-based 173 or Internet-based (iBT) 65
