

#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

- Students in both programs study basic automotive theory, as well as components from Level I of the Automotive Technician apprenticeship curriculum
- In the second year, students receive training that closely resembles Levels II and III of the in-class apprenticeship curriculum
- Technicians graduate with a knowledge of small business management, management principles, and safe environmental practices
- SEMA has invited Loyalist students to participate in its student internship program for the past seven years the only college automotive program in Canada to be extended this invitation
- This is not an apprenticeship program; however, the instruction incorporates a large component of the in-class curriculum.
   Graduates who wish to pursue an apprenticeship with an employer may obtain cross-accreditation from their regional apprenticeship office



#### **CAREER OPPORTUNITIES**

- The image of motive power tradespeople has evolved from stereotypical mechanics to skilled workers who possess refined knowledge, diagnostic abilities and business management skills
- Graduates work in dealerships, manufacturers, service and repair shops, parts distributors, retail stores, wholesalers, insurance appraisers and adjustors, and manufacturing plants for automotive-related items. Activities may include repairs, writing customer service orders, sales, customer relations, parts counter service, warranty claim processing, supervision, and insurance appraisal. You may also work toward a career as a service writer or shop manager
- A one-year certificate prepares you for a career as parts and counter personnel, with entry-level salaries starting from approximately \$30,000
- A two-year diploma will prepare you to progress to a position as a technician, along with the practical training to manage a small business or franchise. Entry-level salaries start from approximately \$35,000
