

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- Develop hands-on skills in all aspects of the radio industry: on-air performance, creative writing, audio production, sales, marketing, promotions, programming and web content development
- Put theory into practice in a live, on-air environment that will prepare you for broadcast conditions in the industry
- Students operate two broadcast properties at Loyalist College: 91X (CJLX-FM 91.3), a licensed, full-power community-college radio station serving the local region; and Hot Hits, Loyalist's Internet radio station, both of which are equipped with the latest digital automation system, production equipment, and music scheduling software

APPROXIMATE COSTS (2013-2014)

Domestic Tuition/Ancillary Fees: \$3,659 (two semesters) Consumables Fee: \$175 (Year One)

Supplies: \$230

Students must budget for a four-week placement at the end of their second year. Additional costs, such as travel and parking, may be incurred during placements
