

# IMPORTANT DATES

## What's due and When?

To ensure your place in Residence, please be aware of these important dates.

Failure to complete all of these steps will result in the loss of your room in Residence.

All correspondence should be mailed to:

**Due 3 weeks after post-marked date on the Residence Acceptance Package**

1. **\$500 deposit due** for new Residence students. **Returning Residence students** must top up their deposit, if necessary, to \$500 (you will receive an invoice in the mail if there is an amount owing).
2. **Complete and return your Room Assignment Questionnaire** (form enclosed).
3. **Sign and return the Residence Agreement** (form enclosed).

**After you have accepted your offer to Residence and to your program at Loyalist**

You will receive a Pre-Bill from the College outlining the different payment options available. **Please complete and return the Pre-Bill to select your payment option.** Costs are as follows, subject to change:

**Suite-style Residence fees** \$5,600

**Deferral Fee** \$100 (This non-refundable amount will be added to your account if you choose an option to defer payment.)

**Mid-June**

You will receive an invoice outlining the payments due based upon the payment option you select on the Pre-Bill form that you return to the College.

Any fees not received by the specified dates will be deemed as not accepting an offer for Residence and will result in an automatic loss of your room. Your \$500 deposit will be returned to you, less a \$150 administration charge.

**Withdrawals**

Any student withdrawing from Residence prior to August 24, 2014 is subject to a \$150 administration charge. A \$500 withdrawal fee is charged for any withdrawal on or after August 24, 2014 or at any time during the academic year. All Residence withdrawals must be submitted in writing to the attention of the Residence Manager.

**First week of August**

Watch for the next Residence package to arrive during the first week of August. It will contain your room assignment and other exciting information about your new home!

## RESIDENCE: WELCOME HOME



## Loyalist's on-campus residences form an active, close-knit community.

Our suite-style Residences include five buildings in a wooded country setting:

- We have accommodation for 476 students on campus, just minutes from class.
- Each unit has been designed as an apartment containing six individual bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen and a common living area.
- Students have their own private, carpeted bedroom with a window, furnished with a twin captain's bed, night table, dresser, desk and chair, desk lamp, bookshelf and corkboard.
- Kitchen and dining areas are equipped with a fridge, stove, microwave, dishwasher, dining table and chairs, two loveseats and a coffee table.
- Barrier-free apartments are available in three buildings.
- You can request to live on a floor (or building) that is designated as a **quiet floor** or **alcohol free**. You can request either of these options on the Roommate Questionnaire Form.

We also have four new, **fully furnished townhouse buildings** for returning students:

- Each unit includes four individual bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen and a common living area.
- Bedrooms are equipped with a double bed, night table, dresser, study desk and chair.
- The townhouse-style residences are available for our returning students only, with 104 spots available.
- Fees are based on a 10-month lease (from July through April).



## RESIDENCE COMMONS

The Commons provides an informal and security-protected area for students to hang out, grab a coffee, watch a movie or a game on the big screen TV, study, or catch a peer's performance in one of the featured open mic nights.

The centrally located Residence Commons offers:

- Computer lab
- Individual and group study rooms
- Café-style food centre open in the evenings
- Lounge area with limestone fireplace
- Sunken living room with big screen TV
- Pool tables
- All-new laundry facilities



## OUTDOOR RECREATION

The Residence grounds include:

- Partially fenced-in sports pad with basketball hoops
- Two outdoor bicycle sheds
- Picnic tables
- Sheltered outdoor patio with barbecues
- Sand volleyball court
