PROGRAM LENGTH

One-Year Ontario College Graduate Certificate

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This graduate program is designed to build on the knowledge, skills, and competencies required to care for those with dementia and enhance the quality of life for those with dementia, their caregivers and families.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Successful completion of an approved diploma or degree in health or social sciences, including Nursing, Developmental Services Worker and Social Services Worker
- All instruction will be in English. In order to be successful in the program speaking, listening, and comprehension, along with reading and writing skills, must be at a level sufficient to meet the demands of post-secondary studies. All international applicants are required to submit an English proficiency score with the following minimum IELTS scores with their application.
- IELTS: 6.5 overall with a minimum score of 6.0 in each section is accepted, 7.0 is recommended
