One-Year Ontario College Graduate Certificate

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This program is designed to provide a theoretical knowledge base in gerontology, followed by a clinical practicum targeted at application of theory and concepts learned throughout the program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Successful completion of an approved degree or diploma in health or social sciences
- All instruction will be in English. In order to be successful in the program, speaking, listening, and comprehension, along with reading and writing skills, must be at a level sufficient to meet the demands of post-secondary studies. All international applicants are required to submit an English proficiency score with the following minimum IELTS scores with their application
- IELTS: 6.5 overall with a minimum score of 6.0 in each section is accepted, 7.0 is recommended
