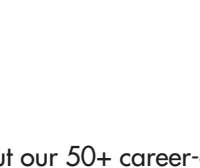

We were very pleased when our daughter chose Loyalist. She selected the program she wanted and is playing varsity basketball – so we are able to continue to show our support at her games.



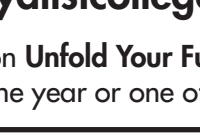
